

Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) 2015-2016 FELLOWSHIP COMPETITION for Undergraduate Students in STEM Fields

for Chinese, Japanese, Korean and other East Asian languages

The East Asian Studies Center (EASC) at The Ohio State University (OSU) is seeking applications for fellowships for Summer Semester 2015 and Academic Year 2015-2016 under the U.S. Department of Education's Title VI Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) Fellowship program. These fellowships are available to undergraduate students of junior or senior standing in a Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics (STEM) field who will have successfully completed two years of East Asian language study at the college level by the start of the fellowship.

ACADEMIC YEAR (AY) FELLOWSHIPS: AY fellowships are expected to carry a stipend of \$5,000 and contribute \$10,000 towards tuition and fees. Subject to approval, AY FLAS fellowships may also be used for foreign language and area studies at other U.S. or foreign institutions. Because FLAS Fellowships are language and area study-based, all AY award recipients must be enrolled in at least one three-credit, graded, classroom-taught language course and at least one three-credit, graded, classroom-taught area studies course each semester during the tenure of the fellowship. AY award recipients must also be full-time students (at least 12 credit hours per semester). In order to gauge each student's language progress during the period of their fellowship, recipients are also required to take a language proficiency entrance examination in the beginning of the academic year and an exit examination at the end of the academic year. FLAS Fellows are also required to meet with the FLAS Coordinator prior to the start of each semester to discuss their course load and program of study. In addition, recipients are required to submit a post-fellowship online report to the U.S. Department of Education, and participate in brief bi-annual surveys on their job placement and use of language skills for eight years post-graduation. If a Fellow fails to meet any of these requirements, money may be withheld and/or he/she will be required to return the money given to them including payments for tuition.

SUMMER (SU) FELLOWSHIPS: SU fellowships are expected to carry a stipend of \$2,500 and an award for tuition and partial OSU fees (up to \$5,000). SU fellowships are awarded for intensive language study only. Intensive programs eligible for support must encompass the equivalent of a full year of language study with at least 120 contact/classroom hours in instruction for advanced language levels and 140 hours for beginning and intermediate language levels and offer at least 6 weeks of instruction. Individualized instruction, dissertation research and audited classes are ineligible for a Summer FLAS. SU fellowships may be used for intensive language study at institutions other than OSU including study abroad. In such cases, applicants must provide itemized data on tuition, fees, and room and board expenses using the attached Language Instruction Budget Estimate form. Summer award recipients must register for a minimum of six credit hours of language courses during the award period. They are also required to meet with the FLAS Coordinator prior to the start of their program as well as take a language proficiency entrance and exit exam before and after their program of study. In addition, recipients must submit a post-fellowship online report to the U.S. Department of Education, and participate in brief bi-annual surveys on their job placement and use of language skills for eight years post-graduation. If a Fellow fails to meet any of these requirements, support may be withheld and/or he/she will be required to return funds given to them, including payments for tuition and fees.

REQUIREMENTS: All applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents. Undergraduate FLAS awards are restricted to students in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) fields; for a list of relevant majors, see http://undergrad.osu.edu/pdf/OSU_STEM.pdf or consult EASC with any questions. Applicants must also be of junior or senior standing at time of fellowship and have successfully completed two years of East Asian language study at the college level before the start of the fellowship. Additionally, undergraduate applicants are required to have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.4. U.S. government regulations require all recipients of a FLAS travel award (available in some circumstances for summer fellows) to comply with the provisions appearing in the Fly America Act. Specifically, all tickets for overseas flights purchased with U.S. Dept. of Education funds must be on a U.S. carrier unless the traveler is able to meet specific exemption requirements.

LANGUAGE ELIGIBILITY: Awards will be made through EASC for Chinese, Japanese, or Korean. Applications for other East Asian languages (e.g. Tibetan, Uyghur, Uzbek, Mongolian) will also be considered. If applying for an award in more than one language, separate applications for each language/area study focus must be submitted. Applicants are responsible for contacting appropriate language departments and establishing that their requested level of language instruction will be offered in 2015-16.

PRIORITIES: In awarding fellowships, consideration will be given to applicants with academic merit and professional potential. Highest priority will be given to candidates proposing to study at the advanced level (Level 3 or higher) who also demonstrate financial need as defined in Part F of Title VI of the Higher Education Act of 1965. Second-highest priority will be given to students planning to study at the advanced levels (Level 3 or higher) before entering government service.

Note: The awarding of fellowships is dependent upon the continued receipt of Title VI funding from the U.S. Department of Education.

Application Procedures

The APPLICATION DEADLINE is **Monday, February 2, 2015 at 4:30 PM** for both Summer 2015 and Academic Year 2015-2016 fellowship applications.

Applicants are eligible to apply for both summer and academic year fellowships. Contact the East Asian Studies Center (614-688-4253, easc@osu.edu) with any questions regarding your application for an East Asia FLAS Fellowship. No consideration will be given to forms that are incompletely or improperly filled out.

A complete application includes the following:

- 1) The completed Undergraduate Students in STEM Fields **Application Form** for the East Asian Studies Center FLAS fellowship. Application forms are available from EASC (314 Oxley Hall, 1712 Neil Ave.), and online at http://easc.osu.edu/fellowships/undergrad/flas. Please note that there are separate applications for summer and academic year fellowships.
- 2) An up-to-date **OSU advising report** of all college courses taken and grades received, as well as official transcripts from any previous college level study at other institutions.

(Note: Applicants for both summer and academic year fellowships need only submit one advising report and/or transcript.)

- 3) A one-page single-spaced **Statement of Intent** (see page 3 of both the Summer and Academic Year applications).
- 4) Three letters of reference from faculty members familiar with the student's work, including:
 - -One letter from a STEM faculty who can speak to the applicant's qualifications in STEM, and preferably to how the applicant plans to combine STEM with an international career
 - -One letter from a language faculty at the college level to speak to applicant's language ability
- -One letter from a faculty in any field that can speak to applicant's commitment to international studies Letters are to be sent directly by the referee to the East Asian Studies Center. Applicants for both summer and academic year fellowships need only submit one set of references.
- 5) Completed Summer and Academic Year Language Instruction **Budget Estimate forms**. (Note: For students attending summer programs abroad or intensive language programs in the U.S., all information regarding budget and program application contact information must be included with the FLAS application.)
- 6) Applicants must also separately submit a **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** to OSU's Office of Student Financial Aid by their priority deadline of February 15, 2015. (Note: As the U.S. Department of Education asked FLAS-awarding Centers in its 2014-18 Title VI Request for Proposals to give preference to students with both academic merit and financial need, EASC now requires all FLAS applicants to submit a FAFSA application as a means of determining financial need. Student Financial Aid will calculate each applicants' financial need and provide EASC with an estimated dollar figure. EASC will not have access to applicants' FAFSA applications or personal information contained therein. Students do not have to accept any financial aid or loan as a result of submitting the FAFSA. STUDENTS MUST SUBMIT A FAFSA THROUGH http://sfa.osu.edu/ IN ORDER FOR THEIR FLAS APPLICATION TO BE CONSIDERED COMPLETE.)
