This is a new course offered jointly by Ohio State University, University of Michigan, and Michigan State University.



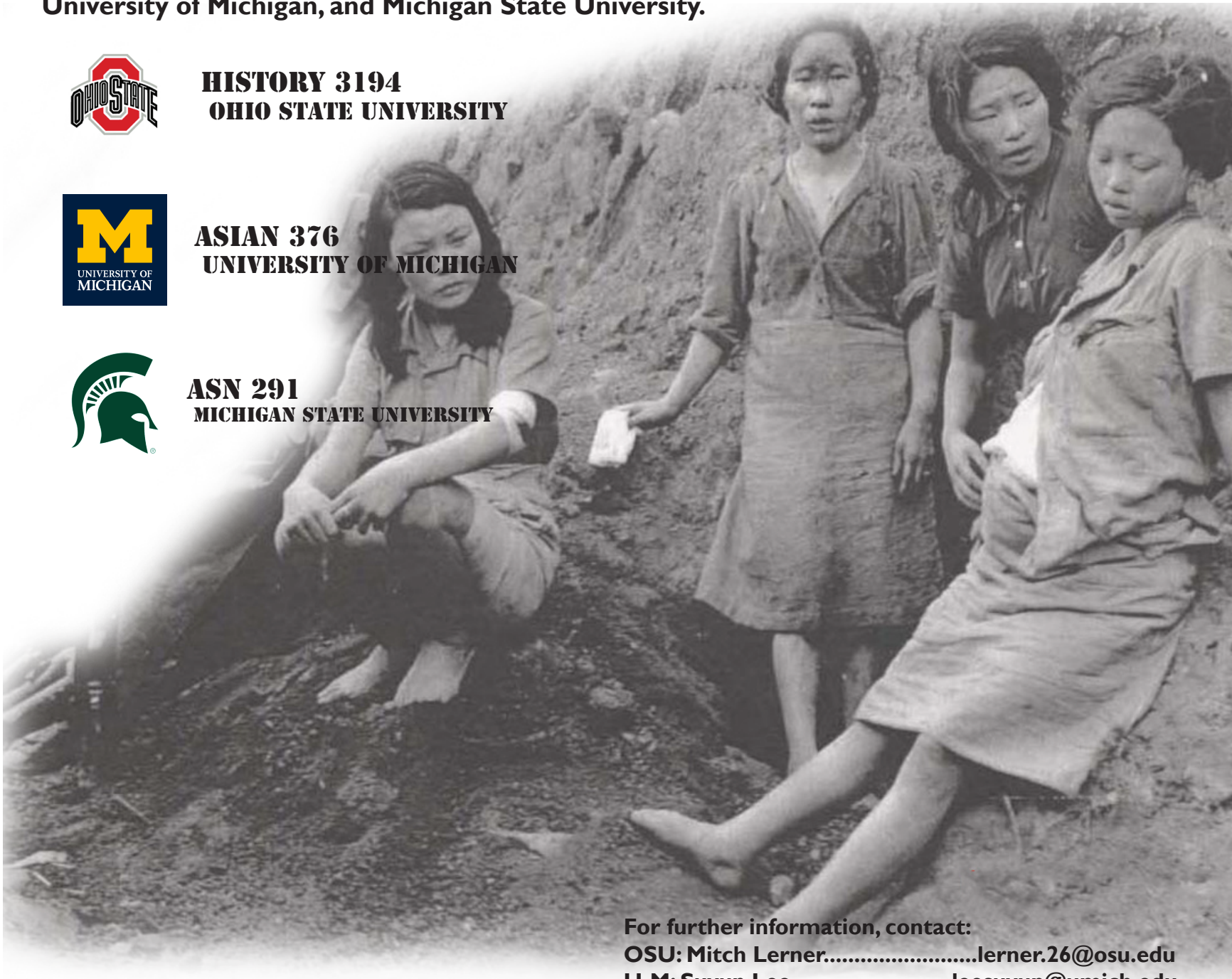
