

Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) 2014-2015 FELLOWSHIP COMPETITION for Undergraduate Students in STEM Fields

for Chinese, Japanese, Korean and other East Asian languages

The East Asian Studies Center (EASC) at The Ohio State University (OSU) is seeking applications for fellowships for Summer Semester 2014 and Academic Year 2014-2015 under the U.S. Department of Education's Title VI Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) Fellowship program. These fellowships are available to undergraduate students of junior or senior standing in a Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics (STEM) field who have successfully completed two years of East Asian language study at the college level by the start of the fellowship. Summer 2014 fellowships are expected to cover \$5,000 in tuition and fee support and also provide a \$2,500 stipend. Academic Year 2014-2015 fellowships are expected to contribute \$10,000 towards tuition and fees and also provide a \$5,000 stipend.

Subject to approval, academic-year FLAS fellowships may also be used for foreign language and area studies at other U.S. or foreign institutions. Because FLAS Fellowships are language and area study-based, all academic-year award recipients must be enrolled in at least one three-credit, classroom-taught language course and at least one three-credit area studies course each semester during the tenure of the fellowship. Academic-year award recipients must also be full-time students. In order to gauge each student's language progress during the period of their fellowship, recipients are required to take a language proficiency entrance examination in the beginning of the academic year and an exit examination at the end of the academic year. FLAS Fellows are also required to meet with the FLAS Coordinator prior to the start of each semester to discuss their course load and program of study. In addition, all recipients are required to submit pre-fellowship and post-fellowship online reports to the U.S. Department of Education, and participate in brief bi-annual surveys on their job placement and use of language skills for eight years post-graduation. If a Fellow fails to meet any of these requirements, money may be withheld and/or he/she will be required to return the money given to them including payments for tuition.

Summer fellowships are awarded for intensive language study only. Intensive programs eligible for support must encompass the equivalent of a full year of language study with at least 120 contact/classroom hours in instruction for advanced language levels and offer at least 6 weeks of instruction. Individualized instruction and audited classes are ineligible for a Summer FLAS. Summer fellowships may be used for intensive language study at institutions other than OSU including study abroad. In such cases, applicants must provide itemized data on tuition, fees, and room and board expenses using the attached Language Instruction Budget Estimate form. Summer award recipients must register for a minimum of 6 semester credit hours of language courses during the award period. They are also required to meet with the FLAS Coordinator, take a language proficiency entrance and exit exam before and after their program of study, submit both pre-fellowship and post-fellowship online reports to the Department of Education, and participate in brief bi-annual surveys on their job placement and use of language skills for eight years post-graduation. If a Fellow fails to meet any of these requirements, support may be withheld and/or he/she will be required to return funds given to them, including payments for tuition and fees.

Undergraduate FLAS awards are restricted to students in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) fields; for a list of relevant majors, see http://undergrad.osu.edu/pdf/OSU_STEM.pdf. Applicants must also be of junior or senior standing and have successfully completed two years of East Asian language study at the college level before the start of the fellowship. Additionally, undergraduate applicants are required to have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.4. All applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents. U.S. government regulations require all recipients of a FLAS travel award (available in some circumstances for summer fellows) to comply with the provisions appearing in the Fly America Act. Specifically, all tickets for overseas flights purchased with U.S. Dept. of Education funds must be on a U.S. carrier, unless the traveler is able to meet specific exception requirements.

Awards will be made through EASC for Chinese, Japanese, and Korean. Applications for other East Asian languages (e.g. Tibetan, Uyghur, Mongolian) will also be considered. If applying for an award in more than one language, separate applications for each language/area study focus must be submitted. In awarding Summer 2014 fellowships, priority will be given to students who are likely to enter government service or a professional field. Lowest priority will be given to native-level speakers. In awarding Academic Year 2014-2015 fellowships, EASC will base its priorities off of the 2014-2018 FLAS competition priorities expected to be announced by the U.S. Department of Education in February 2014.

Applicants are responsible for contacting language departments at OSU or elsewhere and establishing that their requested level of language instruction will be offered in 2014-2015.

Please note: The awarding of Academic Year 2014-15 FLAS fellowships is dependent upon the award of Title VI FLAS funding for EASC in the national 2014-2018 FLAS grant competition operated by the U.S. Department of Education.

Application Procedures

The APPLICATION DEADLINE is **Monday, February 3, 2014 at 4:30 PM** for both Summer 2014 and Academic Year 2014-2015 fellowship applications.

Applicants are eligible to apply for both summer and academic year fellowships. Contact the East Asian Studies Center (614-688-4253, easc@osu.edu) with any questions regarding your application for an East Asia FLAS Fellowship. No consideration will be given to forms that are incompletely or improperly filled out.

A complete application includes the following:

- 1) The completed Undergraduate Students in STEM Fields **Application Form** for the EASC FLAS fellowship. Application forms are available from EASC (314 Oxley Hall, 1712 Neil Ave.), and online at http://easc.osu.edu. Please note that there are separate applications for summer and academic year fellowships.
- 2) An up-to-date **OSU advising report** of all college courses taken and grades received (Note: Applicants for both summer and academic year fellowships need only submit one set of transcripts.)
- 3) A one-page single-spaced **Statement of Intent** (see page 3 of both the Summer and Academic Year applications).
- 4) Three letters of reference from faculty members familiar with the student's work, including:
 - -One letter from a STEM faculty that can speak to the applicant's qualifications in STEM, and preferably to how the applicant plans to combine STEM with an international career
 - -One letter from a language faculty at the college level to speak to applicant's language ability
 - -One letter from a faculty in any field that can speak to applicant's commitment to international studies

Letters are to be sent directly by the referee to the East Asian Studies Center. Applicants for both summer and academic year fellowships need only submit one set of references.

5) Completed Summer and Academic Year Language Instruction **Budget Estimate forms**. (Note: For students attending summer programs abroad or intensive language programs in the U.S., all information regarding budget and program application contact information must be included with the FLAS application.)

Applicants can submit materials one of two ways:
