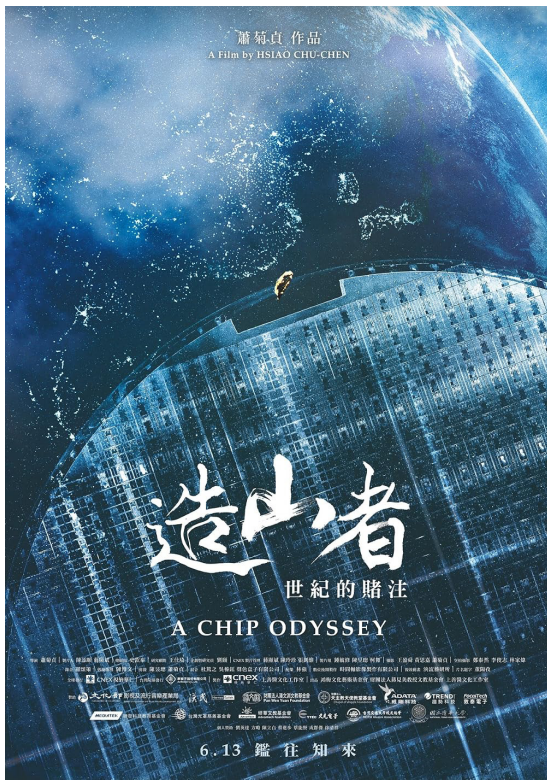




Film Screening: *A Chip Odyssey*
