



Freeman Foundation Asia Internship Scholarship

Ohio State's East Asian Studies Center, with generous funding from the Freeman Foundation, is offering scholarships to select undergraduate students for a transformative internship experience in Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, Singapore, or other Asian countries.

Details

- Salary: Internships are unpaid, but students are given a generous scholarship (up to \$7,000) to help offset expenses such as international and domestic travel, program costs, insurance (in country), food, and housing.
- Timeframe: May – Mid-August 2027 (in country).
- Term: Minimum 6 weeks, typically 8 weeks. 40 hours of work per week.
- Priority application deadline, Dec. 11, 2026.

Eligibility

- Must be a full-time undergraduate student enrolled in a degree-seeking program in ANY major.
- Applicants must complete at least 30 credit hours of coursework before start of internship.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above.
- Participants are required to take a 1-credit, post-internship course in Autumn 2027.
- You do NOT need to have a background in an East Asian language for most placements.
