We need non-native Japanese language learners who are willing to serve as practice interviewees for the **Japanese Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) Workshop** EASC is hosting this May on the OSU campus. This only takes 30 minutes and is a great practice for teachers and students at any level of Japanese. Details:

- Students studying Japanese are needed, usually in second, third and fourth (or above) year of study. We especially need Novice and Intermediate level speakers.
- Interviews last about 30 minutes. No preparation is needed. Each person needs only help with one interview.
- The time and day of each practice interview is determined by language level.
- Parking token and \$25 gift certificate provided.
- Interviewees are not graded, you are helping the trainees.
- Unofficial evaluation level can be given.

Interview candidates are needed as follows:

May 23 (Wednesday): Levels: Novice and Intermediate - Students in their second or third year of

college language study (or equivalent).

May 24 (Thursday): Levels: Intermediate, Advanced and Superior - Students in at least the

fourth year of college study with overseas experience, graduate students, non-native speaking faculty or members of the community of a very high

level of competence.
