- Proctors will need to be at the test site all day (training in the morning, lunch, then test in the afternoon). Estimated schedule 8am—4:30pm.
- Proctors can be Japanese language teachers or speakers of Japanese.
- Not all proctors need to speak Japanese (only one proctor per room needs to speak Japanese).
- Proctors will receive payment (approx. \$100) for the time worked on Dec. 2, provided the person has legal status to receive payment.
- Proctors can also volunteer if they wish, volunteer certificates will be given.
- Proctors will receive lunch and a parking token.
- Proctors should be those that are not considering taking the JLPT in the future.
- Proctors must be at least 18 years of age.
