Problems in Applying Contrastive Analysis to Translation and Ways Out: A Perspective from Chinese and English in Contrast

Contrastive Analysis has seen a decline in application due to its inability to provide a solid and applicable procedure to translation processes. Dr. Shang uses case studies in Chinese-English translation to propose an alternative model of CA-based integrated scientific translation approach, which is assumed to be the first and fundamental layer of translation processes.
