Nissen Chemitec America is an injection molding company located in London, Ohio that supplies plastic interior and exterior automotive parts to Honda. It is a tier 1 supplier. There are about 400 employees, with five Japanese staff.

General Criteria

- Students must be in Level 4 Japanese or higher at OSU.
- To apply for an Interpretation Shadowing experience, please complete the application by **Friday, January 27**.
- The applicants who are accepted into the program will receive a formal email from Allyson Larimer of Nissen Chemitec America with details once your shadowing has been scheduled.
- The participants of the program must sign a non-disclosure agreement. Photographing the parts in the facility is strictly prohibited. The information about the parts obtained during shadowing cannot be shared with other people either.
